

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Notice For Customers If Your Unit Is Equipped With A Power Cord.

WARNING: THIS APPLIANCE SHALL BE CONNECTED TO A MAINS SOCKET OUTLET WITH A PROTECTIVE EARTHING CONNECTION.

The cores in the mains lead are coloured in accordance with the following code:

GREEN and YELLOW - Earth BLUE - Neutral BROWN - Live

As colours of the cores in the mains lead of this appliance may not correspond with the coloured markings identifying the terminals in your plug, proceed as follows:

The core which is coloured green and yellow must be connected to the terminal in the plug marked with the letter E, or with the earth symbol, or coloured green, or green and yellow. The core which is coloured blue must be connected to the terminal marked N or coloured black. The core which is coloured brown must be connected to the terminal marked L or coloured red.

This equipment may require the use of a different line cord, attachment plug, or both, depending on the available power source at installation. If the attachment plug needs to be changed, refer servicing to qualified service personnel who should refer to the table below. The green/yellow wire shall be connected directly to the units chassis.






The utmost care was taken while manufacturing your PS6. Everything should be included and in perfect working order. If anything is missing or damaged, contact the factory at once.



1. POWER INDICATOR LED

This green LED indicates whether or not the PS6 is powered on.

2. POWER OUTPUT CONNECTORS

Connect the included power cables to these output connectors for powering up to six dbx PMC devices.

3. POWER INLET Connect the included IEC power cable to this inlet to provide power to the PS6.

4. FAN

This temperature controlled fan automatically turns on and off as needed.
